# **GENERAL INFORMATION**

# **GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION OF MALTA**

Malta is an island country located in the heart of the Mediterranean Sea, approximately 90 km south of the island of Sicily (Italy) and approximately 290 km north of the African Continent. The Maltese Archipelago consists of a number of islands, the three main ones being Malta, Gozo (Għawdex) and Comino (Kemmuna). It has a population of about 516,000 over a surface area of 316 km<sup>2</sup>, which makes Malta the world's tenth-smallest country in area and the fourth most densely populated sovereign country. Its capital city is Valletta, which is the smallest national capital by area and population in the European Union, with Malta having become a Member State in 2004.

### **ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES**

Malta operates on a 230V supply voltage and 50Hz. The Type G (three-pin rectangular) plug system is used, similar to the UK. Travel adapters can be used, and they are easy to find.



### **OFFICIAL LANGUAGE & CURRENCY**

The official languages in Malta are Maltese and English, although a number of the current Maltese population is at least conversational in the Italian language.

### **EMERGENCY CONTACTS**

The emergency number in Malta to reach medical, fire and police emergency services is **112**.

This Pan-European emergency number 112 can be called from any telephone (landline, pay phone or mobile cellular phone even without a SIM card). Calls are free. It can be used for any life-threatening situation, including:

- serious medical problems (accident, unconscious person, severe injuries, chest pain, seizure);
- any type of fire (house, car);
- life-threatening situations (crimes).

This number should be reserved for emergency cases only. Once through to an operator, the caller should provide their telephone number, address and the location where help is needed, as well as any details about the emergency and the number of people involved.

# <u>TAXI</u>

The white taxi service can pick up passengers from anywhere, except bus stops. Taxi services from Malta International Airport to all localities in Malta are based on a fixed tariff. A taxi from Malta International Airport to The Hilton Malta (St. Julian's) will cost approximately €20.

# TICKETS AND FARES


Single Journey tickets (€1.50) can be purchased from the Bus Driver on the bus to get to any destination. These are valid for a two hours duration, including interchanging.



# Bus from airport to ACCOBAMS MOP8 venue

Route TD2 (direction: 'San Ġiljan') can be used by participants arriving at Malta International Airport. The destination is 'San Ġiljan' Bus Stop. The journey time is approximately 30 minutes.




Once at 'San Ġiljan' Bus Stop, on foot head east on Triq Gort towards St George's Road and turn right. Continue walking along St George's Road towards Triq Ross and turn left. Once you reach the roundabout at the end of Triq Ross, take the second exit onto Vjal Portomaso and you will reach your destination.

### > Bus from Valletta to ACCOBAMS MOP8 venue

Route TD13 (direction: '*Buġibba'*) can be used by Participants catching the bus from Valletta Bus Terminus (Bus Bay A15). The destination is '*Ross'* Bus Stop in St Julian's. The journey time is approximately 17 minutes.



# **ACCOMODATION IN MALTA**

Accommodation is to be arranged by the Participants themselves.

- Room rate for a single room (including breakfast and taxes): €135 per room per night
