The new composition of the Scientific Committee was adopted on a trial basis with a view to being reconsidered at MOP9 (Cyprus, 18-21 November 2025).

During the 2023-2025 triennium, Bureau requested an analysis, taking into account the functionality of the Scientific Committee and the budgetary implications linked with the increased number of Scientific Committee members as well as a legal analysis about the option of electing the Chair and Vice-Chair from among all Scientific Committee Members.

After two calls for Voluntary Contributions in 2023 to support this activity, the Bureau agreed that without sufficient funds by February 2024, it would not be possible to complete the assessment and draft the new Strategy. Since no funds have been received, it is proposed to extend the current Strategy (2018–2025) for the 2026–2028 triennium.
